### **Feed Your Future**

Our food system operates in a significant paradox: the way we produce and consume food jeopardizes the resources that will be needed in the near future to feed the global population. In an era where the challenges of the food system seem so complex, global, and abstract that they appear unsolvable and paralyzing, change can and must begin at the local level, starting from our cities. The Municipality of Milan has accepted this challenge.

For several years, the Municipality of Milan has been involved in the Food Wave project, realized in the implementation of the Municipality's Food Policy. In collaboration with 28 partners from 16 countries Food Wave has the aim of increasing knowledge, awareness, and engagement of young people regarding food consumption patterns and associated behaviors. 2023 marks the closing phase of the project, a moment of reflection on what has been learned and accomplished, but also an opportunity to involve citizens in a collective discussion about the future.

From November 22nd to 25th, the Municipality of Milan, together with Will Media, ActionAid Italy, Fondazione ACRA, Mani Tese will organize "Feed Your Future": three days of public and institutional events aimed at reconsidering our relationship with food and identifying together the solutions to transform it.

The afternoon of November 23rd will be open to anyone who wants to participate, free of charge. We will have the opportunity to explore, design, and imagine together innovations capable of revolutionizing our food system starting from cities. The event will include live conversations with Italian and international guests, on-the-ground experiences, a hackathon, and a documentary screening.

The afternoon of November 24th will be a moment dedicated to the associations supported by the Municipality of Milan within the Food Wave project. Initially, we will learn about the initiatives of city-affiliated associations with the Municipality of Milan that are locally committed to ensuring a sustainable food system. The afternoon will continue with an activity moderated by Will Media to generate a healthy debate on solutions to the problems of the food system.
